PHILADELPHIA (DECEMBER 3, 2018): 2019 **Philly Home Show** and **Philly Home + Garden Show** attendees can explore a variety of home solutions from local experts, gain ideas and insights from TV home design show celebrities, and acquire new craft project skills when the two home shows return to the area in January and February.
