Duties

Working Conditions

Work is outdoors and has varied hours depending on the demands of the project. As with many careers in construction, there are peak periods that will require you to work overtime and periodic out of town travel.

As with all careers in the construction industry, safety is the top priority. You will be required to wear special equipment to protect against injury.

Vehicle for transportation from the office to the job site is provided as well as all tools. Generally the work is on residential sites however, during home show season, installation of enclosures will be required on commercial sites. The job is physically demanding, you will be required to work on ladders and heights, you will have to work with power tools, lift heavy materials and kneel or crouch for long periods of time.

Experience

Although on the job training is required for this position, candidates with previous work experience in general construction, carpentry, or framing are preferred.
