#### IMPORTANT ELECTRICAL CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS

- Each 110 / 120V service connection is 1 cord with 1 outlet. Vendors are not allowed to share their electrical service with another booth.
- Under no circumstances shall anyone other than a Convention Complex electrician make electrical connections into the floor plates or disconnects. Exhibitor will be fined and charged for any damages resulting from attempting to install their own service.
- Walls, columns and permanent building utility outlets are not a part of booth space and are not to be used unless specified otherwise by building management.
- Claims will not be considered unless filed by exhibitor prior to close of exhibition.
- All exhibitor's cords must be of the 3 wire grounded type. All exposed non-current carrying metal parts of fixed equipment, which is liable to be energized, shall be grounded and U.L. listed.
- Rates quoted for all connections cover only the bringing of the service to the booth in the most convenient manner and does not include connecting equipment or special wiring.
- All electrical service comes from floor utility boxes. (No overhead installation.) Only BJCC electricians are allowed in the utility boxes.
- Labor for utility work on equipment, including repairs, tracing malfunction, hook-ups, and working on the equipment can be provided by the Convention Complex electrician at the prevailing rate.
