GREEN WITH EXCELLENCY

Minnesota State Horticultural Society (MSHS) has been a botanical staple of the Home & Garden Show for years, so it was only natural for them to employ this year's show as literal grounds for celebration as they commemorate 150 years of their publication, *Northern Gardener*. What started with a few fruit growers exchanging advice and techniques at the Minnesota State Fair (back in 1866!), like how to grow apples and other plants in this harsh climate, has evolved into a robust publication that largely follows the same exposition: Sharing tried and true gardening tips and ideas to help greenskeepers grow through Minnesota's signature humid summers and harrowing winters. "In a world full of start-ups and pop-up shops, it's becoming increasingly rare to find an organization championing a singular mission for more than a century," says Lara Lau-Schommer, community outreach director for MSHS. "And yet, thanks to thousands of readers and members, MSHS has done just that." At the MSHS booth, attendees will have the ability to purchase *Northern Gardener* and sign up for a membership.

And back by popular demand, the OG gardening source will be hosting its annual bulb, tuber, corm, and bare root plant sale at the show. Lau-Schommer says MSHS will be providing practical tips on how to keep your plant material stored safely until planting season. "We will have a select variety of native seeds for sale that do exceptionally well outdoors using a technique called 'winter seed sowing,'" she says. "Sowing seeds outdoors in the winter is easy, rewarding, and inexpensive." MSHS members will receive 15 percent off plant material purchased at the show.



FLOWER TRENDS FORECAST 2022

Lara Lau-Schommer of MSHS predicts the blooms and backyard bits that will come into vogue this year.

Cut flower gardens. "What could be more fun than designing a beautiful garden for you and your neighbors to enjoy, and then creating stunning bouquets to gift them with?"

Ecological horticulture. "We have learned that gardening is more than just finding the prettiest flowers—it's also about planting native species and creating a habit where birds, bees, and butterflies can flourish." The MSHS booth will



provide step-by-step directions on outdoor winter seed sowing.

Downsizing the lawn. "Many people are planting bee lawns instead of the traditional Kentucky bluegrass to support local pollinators."

DIP YOUR TOE IN THE WATER

Last summer, Minnesotans migrated north for hiking trips, brewery crawls, and other sweet escapes. Being Up North became, quite literally, our north star as we navigated another year of limited living conditions. It got Kym Erickson of Soderberg's Floral and Gifts thinking about our relationship to relaxation and slowing down. "People have realized how important family is, and in Minnesota, being Up North and [together with] family are very integrated things," says Erickson.

Nothing says 'Sota quite like lake life, and that's why Erickson is dedicating this year's Entrance Display to our state's signature cabin aesthetic.

Erickson has made a name for herself at the show over the years, going above and beyond with designs that incorporate botanical inventiveness to make a first impression on showgoers. This year is no different—with a few supply chain-related caveats, causing the price of flowers to go up.

"This year is going to pose a lot of challenges," says Erickson. "It's going to be beautiful. It's going to be amazing, but it might not be as over the top as usual."

Ushering spring hopefuls in, the display captures a quintessential #lakelife scene: On one side, a blazing sunset reflects upon lake waters, flanked by a wooden dock; on the other is a cabin with yard games and hammocks, set in a bed of greenery. Sounds like the perfect respite for a cold and murky March day, right?

For a much-needed pop of color in one of the grayest months of the year, the display also boasts cascades of fresh and artificial flowers and plants. Showgoers can catch a whiff of spring with sweet-smelling tulips upon entry.

Local landscapers show off their inspiration at the Home & Garden Show with the latest trends. Expect a resurgence of trendy water features and clever ways to transform your yard into something more than just a patch of grass. Your next vacation awaits in your own backyard.

A MORNING COFFEE HIDEAWAY

David Ruoho of Tracer Landscape and Concrete noticed that with the onset of COVID, his customers were spending more time at home and reinvesting in their backyard space. Ruoho wants the display to feel like being transported to a little slice of paradise, perfect for sipping a morning beverage or cozing up near an outdoor fireplace in the winter. The addition of flowering shrubs and evergreens offers an extra sense of privacy. "I want everyone to have their own little private oasis."



NOT YOUR GRANDMA'S PERGOLA

Jack Dorsey of Schmig's Land Maintenance will showcase a three-tier garden leading visitors down a cobblestone path accented by shrubs and bulbs. The second level, an outdoor seating area, will be replete with a fireplace and pergola, comprised of clean lines and edges. Perched atop the oasis is a waterfall and hot tub. "The fire pits, hot tubs, and waterfalls give people a reason to go outside. The backyard is no longer just a patio in the middle of the lawn."



BOULDERSCAPING

Justin Ferrin of Stonewall, a company focused on high quality boulder retaining walls and creative natural stone outcroppings, plans to show visitors the myriad ways that boulderscaping can serve a functional purpose while adding a natural elegance to your landscape's aesthetic. "Looking to shore up a lake bank or retain a hillside using stone from northern quarries? We'll help guide you as you weigh the design options."



FIRE THINGS UP

Eric Robertson of NRD Landscape Design + Build has a display that's all about bringing family fun to the backyard. His design includes space with an emphasis on patio (for lounging), an outdoor bar, and fire features for cooking and entertaining. "Given the disruption of 'normal' over the last two years, nothing has been highlighted more than the need to spend time with family and friends. Our space encourages that."

MODERN MEETS FARMHOUSE: MARRYING THE OLD & NEW

Trends from this year's Idea Home you can bring back to your doormat.

As we're all stocking our windowsills and corner nooks with leafy darlings, the Idea Home at this year's Home & Garden Show is blazing a trail to bring the outdoors into our living spaces, where modern lines and minimalism continue their reign. At the merger sits modern farmhouse design, which has been a huge trend of late. "With all the beautiful greenery happening around the Idea Home, our vision was to bring the outdoors in with a light and airy feel throughout," says Tami Beitz of HOM Furniture.

MOTHER NATURE'S THUMBPRINT

The 2022 iteration of the Idea Home is less about the layout and construction, instead emphasizing trends within each space that we can take home and incorporate in myriad ways. The color palette consists of bright white, fresh green, and pops of black. Arguably Mother Nature's favorite hue, green abounds in the natural world (when it's not covered in a mound of white) and is also the main player bringing the outdoors into the Idea Home's design. "2022 will be all about the color green,"

Beitz says. "We've incorporated this hot color throughout the home in bold ways." From a coat of paint to lively plants, this year is quite literally going green.

The kitchen, designed by Rusco Kitchen Remodelers, showcases a green island set against airy whites. The design lightens the visual load by ditching closed upper cabinets in favor of open shelves—creating easier accessibility and putting those gorgeous dishes on display. The large center island, says Savanna Forster of Rusco, "allows for extra space to work while

spending time with family or guests."

It's time to say "Sayonara, stainless!" The modern kitchen implements a black farmhouse sink and black appliances. "Different storage tools allow for better use of the space," Forster says. It features assets like a bread box, knife block inserts, cutlery dividers, garbage pull-outs, built-in pet dishes, spice rack storage, and cutting boards.

The flooring throughout the home is white oak-toned vinyl planking, a current client favorite, Beitz says. The furniture and décor encompass neutral tones, mimicking trending modern California style. "We've used lots of neutral colors and pulled in

textures," Beitz says. "You'll see some caning details and black accents, which have all been very hot."

Highly utilitarian, a bathroom is sometimes hard to make pretty. But Miller Custom Remodeling is showing that you don't have to sacrifice functionality for beauty. A balanced cocktail of white, black, and gray creates a modern, pared-down façade, while shiplap and barn doors nod to the warmer farmhouse feel.

LAYERING UP FOR THE OUTDOORS

The exterior of the Idea Home is "highlighting the informal, inviting side of living and embracing functionality," says Jordan

Jaacks of Diamond Kote. Board and batten siding creates a layered look and is finished in Glacier Fog, a new Diamond Kote color. "It is a neutral-toned off-white color and pairs well with warm and cool colors," Jaacks says. The black-on-white exterior is overtaking the muted tones of suburban neighborhoods, and the Idea Home is leading the way. Onyx trim will, Jaacks says, "match the color of the windows and work as a complement to Glacier Fog, along with adding the modern flair on the exterior of the house." Against the board and batten, variegated brown Sterling Tight Cut Versetta Stone accents warm up the face of the home and add hints of natural texture.

**BRIGHTER
DAYS AWAIT**

LOCAL ARTIST DREW BESON CAN HELP YOU DITCH THE DREARY GRAYS AND STARK WHITES FOR VIBRANT HUES THIS SPRING—ALL WITH A WAVE OF HIS HAND. **BY NINA RAEMONT**

After two years of being swathed in gray—gray days, gray news, actual graying hair—it's time to leave the doldrums behind and get immersed in ruby reds, cerulean blues, and neon greens. Drew Beson, a born-and-raised Minnesotan and abstract artist, can help you add a touch of sparkle to your surroundings via a collection of art he's selling at the Home & Garden Show.

To ring in his first year at the show, he's giving showgoers a little something special. In addition to browsing his transcendent paintings, you can also watch him perform a live painting on Saturday.

Once homeowners realized they were in the pandemic for the long run, folks became more thoughtful about how they wanted to present on Zoom. Soon enough, those home office back-grounds became a sort of workplace cultural capital. That's when Beson started receiving a boatload of inquiries from art-curious customers. "You might be doing Zoom calls with no pants on, but if you've got great art in the background, and you've got good lighting and good audio, you can look like a million bucks," he says.

If you shudder every time you look at your bare walls or are considering a décor revamp, a touch of abstract art may just be the pick-me-up your space needs. "It's not very often that I could include 60,000 guests in an event like the Home & Garden Show," says Beson. "I certainly wouldn't want to pick up the bar tab for that!"

A HOUSE SUBDIVIDED

Professional fixer-upper and star of HGTV's *Good Bones* Mina Starsiak Hawk talks about the multidimensional concept of "home," the great open floor plan debate, and the value of sweat equity. **BY JAMIE KORF**

The impact of the pandemic has been felt in so many ways—and maybe, most notably, in how we view our homes. What does "home" mean to you?

I think for many, it transformed into home office, home gym, home day care...

People really had to figure out how to make their lives function in a way they never had to out of one singular location. Being in construction, my work has stayed outside the home and hasn't really stopped.

In all the houses you've flipped over the 60-plus episodes of *Good Bones*, which project stood out to you in terms of favorites? What did you like most about it?

My forever home, of course! I did all the things I ever wanted and made it work perfectly for my family. (Editor's note: Starsiak Hawk's home is a three-story new build with 2,900 square feet, inspired by the old-style architecture of Charleston.)

How have floor plans changed during these entropic times?

I think there was a huge push to open concept, and while I don't think that will go away, there does seem to be some growing desire for a middle ground between traditional divided rooms and the newer idea of complete open concept.

What are 2–3 affordable renovation projects that can boost the value of a home? What about a couple of known "improvements" that actually turn buyers off?

Putting sweat equity into your exterior can definitely increase the value! New planting beds, a porch paint refresh, maybe even a couple of new light fixtures or door handles. Pools and hot tubs do nothing for property value, so skip those. Dramatic or personal paint color choices can also be a bad idea.

What's next for the most beloved mother-daughter duo in the home improvement world?

Mom is living the retired life and loving it! For me, I have my store, Two Chicks District Co., that's been up and running for 18 months, and I'm launching my kids line this month there. I am also filming my spin-off to *Good Bones* called *Risky Business*! There's not really anything off the table.

What can Home & Garden attendees expect from your appearance at the show?

I'll of course give a little background, like a brief "State of the Union," but I really like to have an open dialogue and hear what the attendees are interested in learning about. Work, family, life ... all of it.
