STAR OF THE SHOW

HOME + GARDEN SHOW

POP STAR, A NEW VARIETY OF THE BEST-SELLING ENDLESS SUMMER HYDRANGEAS FROM MINNESOTA'S BAILEY NURSERIES, WILL BE MAKING ITS DEBUT AT THE MINNEAPOLIS HOME + GARDEN SHOW. BY TAYLOR HUGO

If you're not familiar with the horticulture industry, you might be surprised to discover that the best-selling hydrangea in the world has Minnesota ties. Bailey Nurseries, a 118-year-old wholesale grower headquartered in St. Paul, introduced its Endless Summer hydrangeas in 2004. At the time, it was the first-ever reblooming hydrangea, skyrocketing to popularity for its ability to sprout flowers on old and new wood, meaning you get multiple sets of blooms in one growing season.

"Before Endless Summer, we really couldn't grow that type of hydrangea in Minnesota because there wasn't anything that was cold-hardy enough to handle our winters," says Ryan McEnaney, Bailey's marketing and communications manager and part of the fifth generation of the family-owned nursery. Now, nearly 20 years since the debut of Endless Summer, Bailey is preparing for its biggest national release to date—Pop Star, the newest variety of the Endless Summer hydrangea—and Minneapolis Home + Garden Show attendees will get an exclusive look.

"We're going to be building excitement as we come out of winter and people are starting to dream about what they want to do in their gardens this year," says McEnaney. "Attendees will be able to see the beauty of Pop Star and plan how they can use it in their landscapes and then be able to find it at their local garden centers."

Unlike the typical snowball shape that comes to mind when you envision a hydrangea plant, Pop Star features a lacecap design with flat, frilly blossoms that encircle a round disk of shorter, smaller florets. Its compact size, reaching no more than 2 feet tall in Minnesota, makes Pop Star a versatile choice for both gardens and pots, and its rebloom time—only four weeks after a hard cutback, which is the quickest in production—means you can trim a bouquet of flowers for your kitchen table and new blooms will take their place.

Pop Star is just one example of the literal groundbreaking work that comes out of Bailey Innovations, the nursery's inhouse plant-breeding program based near Athens, Georgia. With a focus on producing plants with the best genetics possible, Bailey Innovations will research and test tens of thousands of seedlings before a final product is released.

"Our goal is not to bring out the most new varieties. Our goal is to bring out the best new varieties," says McEnaney of Bailey. "We look at things like disease resistance, pollinator friendliness, and sustainability with low water usage. So, we have breeding objectives and problems we're trying to solve so that we're bringing something truly unique and different to the marketplace."

In addition to flooding the Home + Garden Show with 400 hydrangeas for visi-

tors to admire, McEnaney and others from Bailey Nurseries will be on hand to talk about different types of hydrangeas, how to use and care for them, and trends that are currently dominating garden spaces, such as native plants, which are local to where you live and good for the environment, and plants that serve a purpose. (Think: hedges that offer privacy around a patio.)

McEnaney is also looking forward to connecting with attendees and helping them solve their garden problems. "Feel free to use us as a resource. We're excited to be here," he says. "What's so fun about our work is that we get to help people create really beautiful spaces and help them be successful."

HYDRANGEA CARE 101

PLACEMENT. Find an area in your landscape that gets morning sun and dappled afternoon shade—under a tree, for example. Full sun will scorch the petals and the leaves.

WATERING. Hydrangeas have a reputation for being water hogs, which causes people to overwater them. This will push nutrients and oxygen out of the soil to the point that the hydrangea doesn't have what it needs to survive and thrive. "Hydrangeas like evenly moist soil, not too dry, not too wet—the Goldilocks experience,"

PRUNING. Never do any hard pruning with hydrangeas. In our area, wait until at least Mother's Day, let those leaves start to emerge, and then trim only back to the green.

FERTILIZER. As soon as you start to see green leaves emerge in the spring, give your hydrangea a good shot of bloom-boosting fertilizer. Then, hit it with another shot around the fourth of July, when the second set of flower buds starts to develop. "That's it," says McEnaney. "When it comes to hydrangeas, less is more."





COMPLEMENTARY COLORS

HGTV's Unsellable Houses stars and twin sisters Leslie Davis and Lyndsay Lamb talk tasteful trends and textures, twinning, and how to retool your home without breaking the bank. BY REBECCA MENNECKE

ven when they're off-screen, Leslie
Davis and Lyndsay Lamb's renovations blend the best of the eras we've
lived in—from the wicker chairs of the '90s
to the chunky patterns and textures of the
'70s. Davis and Lamb are currently making
big moves with bold wallpapers, partnering
with fabric marketplace Spoonflower to
feature some of their favorite designs in the
next season of *Unsellable Houses*. Minimalist
beige, out; flashy patterns, in.

What does it mean to have a home that's "unsellable"?

LESLIE: Every home is sellable, but is it sellable at top dollar? We look at the home being "unsellable" for its maximum potential, and that's what makes it qualify as an unsellable property.

LYNDSAY: Being real estate agents—and being in the market day in and day out—helps us stay in touch with what buyers are looking for, what the trends are in new construction, and what is selling for top dollar.

It's easy to get stuck in the design trends of yesteryear. How do you encourage homeowners to update their sense of style?

LESLIE: Update your paint, fixtures, or staging.

LYNDSAY: Keep it simple. You don't have to change everything in your home to update a space. Small changes go a long way. Try just changing out hardware and a few fixtures in your room to transform the look.

How do you complement each other's work while respecting your differences?

LESLIE: Focusing on each other's strengths and staying in our own lanes.

LYNDSAY: We respect each other's area of expertise. I love Leslie's advice and I like her pushback on design, but I know—when push comes to shove—she'll respect my creative input. The same goes for when she puts a budget in front of me—I can push on it, but when it comes down to it, if something's not in the budget and she says so, I will respect it.

You both have nailed the skill of blending the trends and materials of different eras. What are some of your go-to DIYs?

LESLIE: As much as I hate to admit it, I do think a good wallpaper transforms a space. LYNDSAY: It's so true! A lot of people think wallpaper has to mean a huge expense or a lot of time, but there are ways around that. Maybe you don't use a more complex substrate, or maybe you don't do all four walls. I'm a huge fan of a good DIY. I encourage clients all the time to look online, through magazines, and get inspired by projects they see. You can find inspiration anywhere. Any and everything can become a DIY; it just depends on how hard you're willing to work on it! Everything from lining shelves to an accent wall to a full-room transformation can be a DIY.

When it comes to updating a house, what are some absolute no-nos that homeowners should avoid like the plague?

LESLIE: Don't take on the projects that are over your head. Leave the technical stuff to the pros. Never take on anything that needs to be done by licensed or bonded professionals, like electrical or plumbing.

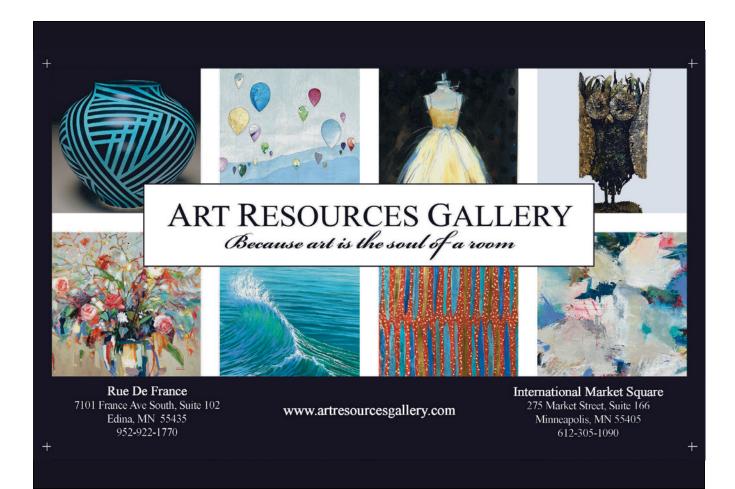
LYNDSAY: I've seen some really sloppy tile work over the years, and it can absolutely stop a buyer from making an offer. Practice on a separate surface in your garage if you're wanting to try before you start applying something you can't easily remove inside your home. If you just don't have the skill for it, don't take it on.

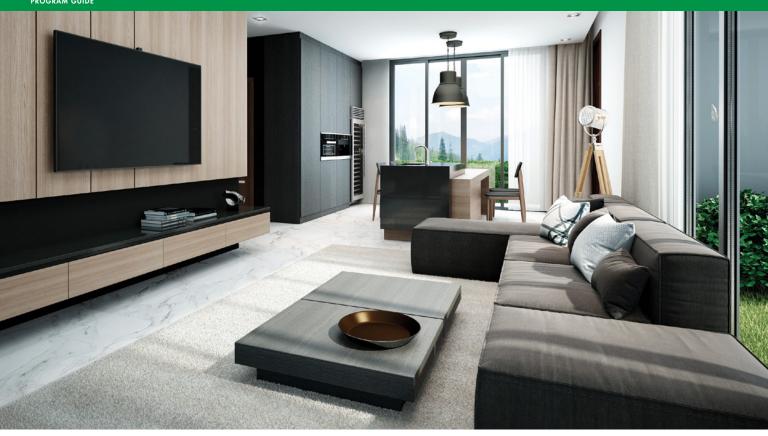
You also run a business, Lamb & Co., where you sell home décor and other home goods. What is your favorite product that you sell?

GOING MODERN SCANDINAVIAN

The 2023 Idea Home at the Minneapolis Home + Garden Show aims to help you unleash the true hygge potential of your home. BY REBECCA MENNECKE

hen you hear the word *hygge*, you probably think of all things calm and cozy—whether that's a hot cup of tea in your favorite mug, a cozy blanket hand-knit by your grandmother, or a brisk spring day in the rain. Basically: anything that *isn't* the typical Minneapolis commute to work, riddled with stress. I'm looking at you, zipper merge.

And while businesses including HOM Furniture, HOM Floors, Rusco Kitchen

Remodelers, Diamond Kote, Pella Windows, and C.M.Wall Construction working together to create a 972-square-foot house inside the Minneapolis Convention Center in less than 72 hours isn't exactly *relaxing*, their creation certainly will be. The 2023 Idea Home at the Minneapolis Home + Garden Show aims to evoke a sense of serenity with its modern Scandinavian theme, showing you just how hygge your home can be.



EXTERIOR

The exterior of the home sets the tone for the Idea Home's modern Scandinavian theme—leaning into lines over angles, simplicity over complexity.

"We're going to show shape," says Patrick Welch, siding specialist at Wausau Supply Company. "We're going to show some horizontal steel siding that has a wood pattern to it that's going to pop."

The exterior of the home will showcase a Scandinavian theme consisting of prefinished Diamond Kote colors of black and white, alongside Vesta steel siding with a wood tone and texture and a light gray Evolve stone product. Wausau Supply specializes in Diamond Kote, a prefinisher for LP SmartSide wood products and something that will appear on the Idea Home. Wausau Supply uses a finish that consists of natural occurring elements that provide you a 30-year no-fade warranty on substrate that has a 50-year warranty. It also consists of a complete siding system. One component or innovation available within the system is a hidden fastening option.

The way Wausau Supply installs the siding has an impact on its overall look as well, Welch says. Using a hidden fastening system allows for quicker installation and fewer nails, offering a cleaner look.

"Our rigid stack is going to lay a lot tighter and straighter on the wall," he says. "A lot of homeowners like that. They like the nice, clean look to it, and that's what we can offer."

INTERIOR DESIGN

Clear lines mixed with natural elements to create a minimalist approach in the way we live in our homes and curate our surroundings is the goal behind HOM Furniture's interior design.

"I always like to create a bit of a zen vibe in every space I design, regardless of the design style," says Tami Beitz, design & development manager for HOM Furniture. "I hope it conveys a sense of calm and peace, while also having warmth and coziness and just a hint of masculinity."

HOM's color palette encompasses the modern Scandinavian theme with raw woods, matte blacks, stone accents, and neutral color tones. Watch out for new products from HOM's new uptown collection—particularly its new upholstery items, which will be showstoppers.

The Idea Home's soothing interiors aim to showcase just how approachable HOM's Design Services are.

"Many people are afraid to have a designer come to their home because they fear judgment or they think it may be too expensive," Beitz says. "Our designers understand that designing your home is a personal process, and they make it fun and help you define your style along the way, while staying within your budget."

HOM has opened several showrooms in the past few years, including its flagship Bloomington showroom, which includes HOM, Gabberts, and Dock86.

KITCHEN AND BATH

The designs for the kitchen and bath of the Idea Home epitomize the modern Scandinavian theme, combining natural and



 $neutral\,with\,minimalism\,and\,functionality.$

The kitchen will feature black matte cabinets with tons of storage space, thanks to Rev-A-Shelf storage solutions, as well as modern floating shelves, Vicostone quartz countertops, and a sleek wood island.

The bathroom will feature a walk-in shower and Jetta freestanding tub, utilizing the space in a unique way that is sure to inspire. White onyx subway tile gives the walls some texture, while a Bertch vanity gives it some utility.

FROM BRADY BUNCH TO DESIGNS WITH A PUNCH

Christopher Knight on comfort, couches, and his career as Peter Brady. BY REBECCA MENNECKE

ou probably know Christopher Knight as Peter Brady-the sensitive, clumsy, and impulsive middle child on the '70s sitcom The Brady Bunch. But since his successful career playing the part of wholesome kiddo on the show, Knight has transcended his experiences in Hollywood to launch his home furniture brand, the Christopher Knight Home collection.

With products ranging from glassware to bedding, Knight's home collection aims to convey the comforts of home-something he experienced on-screen as an actor and off-screen as the son of a builder.

"I didn't know at the time that I was being affected by what would become an iconic representation of a quintessential American house of the late-'60s, early-'70s period," Knight says. His father, an architect turned actor, and his mom, a Parsons School of Design grad, had perhaps more of an influence on his artistic eye than his experience on The Brady Bunch.

"For me, I tend to be practical, comfortable," Knight says. "I want to melt into my home."

While the Brady family house was simply a Hollywood set, Knight had the unique opportunity in 2019 to renovate the location that served as the exterior trademark we've all come to know and love-that beloved ranch-style split-level home. And that meant blending two of his passions: acting and home furnishing.

"[On HGTV's A Very Brady Renovation] we were paying homage to this thing from our past that had never really been alive," he says. Though he had significant say in how the house transformed into a replica of the inside of the Brady home you can see on TV, he missed how the set-unlike the house-had the living room, dining room, and family room in a unique hexagon-like shape that led to an outdoor patio. It was a stark contrast to today's popular openconcept kitchens and living rooms.

"I mean—one, two bedrooms for six kids and one bathroom?" he says. "That [sounds like] a disaster, but it makes for good television."

Unlike the fictitious sitcom, Knight understands that most families don't have a Pinterest-ready home. Personal interests, personality, and preferences should play a role in how each family designs their home, Knight says, which might mean nabbing a variety of interior design colors, textures, and styles.

"When you look at Christopher Knight Home, it's imperial," he says. "There is no design style. It's boho. It's a mix. It's the things that work for you. Most of us are living in a home that is not dialed in to a particular element-it's a mash-up of things that we own that work together."

Creating a home together as a family can be complicated, trying to integrate everyone's sense of style—especially with a budget in mind. For Knight, that means including

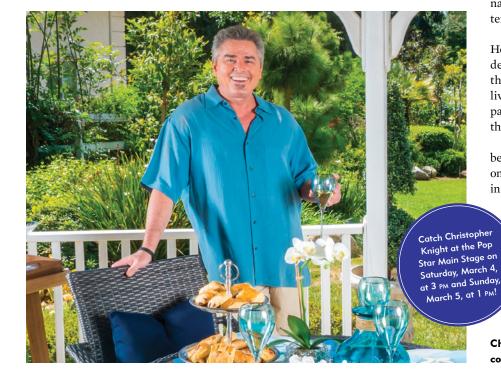

SHEDDING TIERS

FROM UNIQUE DESIGNS TO LUXE AMENITIES, THE UNITS DISPLAYED IN THIS YEAR'S SHED VILLAGE SHOW HOMEOWNERS HOW TO LEVEL UP THEIR WORK AND PLAY SPACE. BY TAYLOR HUGO

Today's sheds have come a long way from being your typical tool-and-lawn-mower outbuilding.

"People want the 'oh my' effect," says Dan Hanes of Barntiques Custom Wood & Design, a custom shed builder in Foley. "We are drawn to the unique, and technology leans into this idea. People often scan the web looking for things that appeal to their senses. Small outbuildings featuring unusual designs catch the eve and are seen as a way to fill out their yard by adding to it and not detracting from it."

At Barntiques, this means chicken coops, saunas, garden sheds, and tree houses, as well as greenhouses, one of which Hanes will present at the show. Standing at 12 feet tall, the 5-by-6-foot, fully electric shed is decorated with wavy white cedar siding, a deck, a tiny cupola, and roofing made from

old corrugated scalloped steel.

With Mountain Lake-based Pro-Shed, homeowners can use the tool on the company's website to craft a completely custom shed—from style and size to paint color. Two of its most popular designs, which will be displayed at the Home + Garden Show, are the backyard studio and classic chalet, complete with finishes like transom windows, double doors, shutters, and dormers.

"This is an affordable way to add an office, study, or hangout to your backyard," says Pro-Shed's Dwayne Wipf. With the company's double-wide option, some are even transforming their sheds into 1,700-squarefoot apartments. "So often, someone will buy a shed and later say, 'I should have gone a little bigger," adds Wipf. "Plan on what you want to do with the shed and make sure it fits your needs."

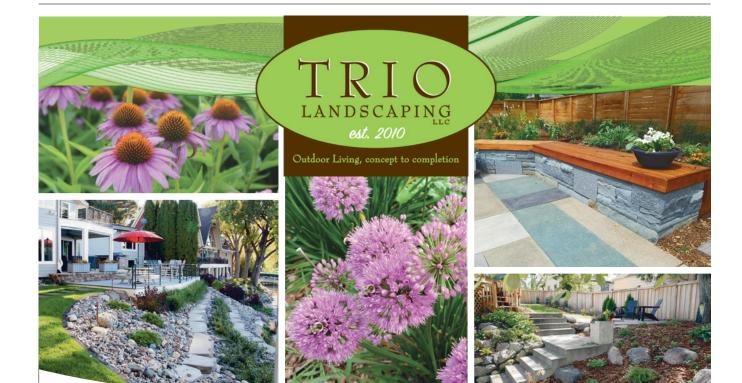
