- I have read the OHS bulletin provided on the Exhibitor Kit page of the Calgary Fall Home Show Website titled “**Workplace Health and Safety Bulletin.**”
- I understand that I am responsible for the safety of those working within my booth.
- I understand that there are no children under the age of 14 allowed on the floor during Move In and Move out as it is considered a construction zone during these times.
- I will clearly indicate who the “Prime” Contractor is if asked by OHS. (it is you if no one else is setting up your booth)
- I will have completed work place hazard assessments while working during set up and tear down at the event.
- I will ensure that any workers within my booth space working at over 3 feet will have appropriate safety restraints.
- I will only operate power tools with the appropriate safety guards.

Does your booth have...	If yes...
CANOPIES/TENTS/DRAPES	
Canopies = roof with one or no sides	10' x 10' or over, must be fire retardant <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tag must be accessible and/or documentation must be available
Tent = roof with two or more sides	10' x 10' or over, must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be fire retardant • Have smoke detector • Have fire extinguisher
Drapes = fabric panels on sides, top or across/above booth space excess of 50% coverage of booth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be fire retardant • Must not be in contact with a direct heat source (i.e. non LED lighting) • Must have documentation available
Trailers/Campers/RV's = closed space surrounded by hard walls with roof	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must have functioning smoke detector installed inside • Must have fire extinguisher present
COOKING/DEMONSTRATION COOKWARE/APPLIANCES	
Cooking = no grease laden vapors (oil, greats, fats, or butter)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be for commercial use only • Must have fire extinguisher present
Demonstration Cookware = pots and pans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cannot use grease laden vapors • Burning food on purpose is not permitted • Must have fire extinguisher present
VEHICLES/EQUIPMENT/MOTORCYCLES	
Vehicles/Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must have Show Management approval prior to arriving on site

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must have no more than ¼ tank of fuel <i>or</i> no more than 20L, whichever is less. • Gas tanks must be locked or sealed • Must have an active smoke detector and fire extinguisher 2A10BC (Vehicles with over 9.3m² of roofed area only) • Must not have propane on, or in the unit
Motorcycle(s)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must have Show Management approval prior to arriving on site • Must have fire extinguisher(s) • Must have spill kit(s) • Refueling of motorcycles must be conducted outside
MISCELLANEOUS/OTHER	
Candles = open flame	Must have a one inch barrier around and above the top of the flame
Propane	Must be stored outdoors
Fresh Cut Trees = cannot be used for display after 14 days from being cut	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must have fire retardant tag with proof of cut date • Must be kept watered
